Biographical sketch	In 1961 Peter Neufeld with his family moved to Minnedosa where he taught high school. In 1967 Peter began his writing career. In the 1980's they resided on a farm named Glendosa Research Centre where Peter developed a new pony breed, the Canadian Rustic.
Custodial history	This collection was housed at the Minnedosa Tribune until October 2007 at which time it was donated to the Minnedosa Regional Archives by Verna Neufeld, daughter of Peter Neufeld.
Scope & content	The collection contains William Albert Fitzgerald's history write up of Reverend John Tanner, father of John "Falcon" Tanner, great-grandfather of John Tanner of Tanner's Crossing; correspondences to Peter Neufeld with Tanner family members in the U.S.; a copy of great-great-granddaughter Marguerite Hussey's book entitled "The Family of Rev. John Tanner - Baptist Preacher, Virginia, North Carolina, Kentucky, Missouri"; Edward C. Tanner family history, plus the history of the descendants of John Falcon Tanner, all of which was donated by Marguerite to Peter Neufeld.
